Due to the pandemic, we were forced to cancel our 2020 IASIU Europe seminar, but we will now hold our 10th conference 2022 in Sweden.

Every year, the European insurance industry pays out around 1 bn EUR in claims settlements (life, health, property and casualty). A rough estimate is that insurance fraud amounts to 5-10 percent of these payments. Insurance fraud is often an incidental crime committed by opportunistic individuals. However, it is also a crime that is becoming increasingly popular among criminal networks. The insurance industry works actively to detect and prevent insurance fraud. In fact, it is the insurance companies' responsibility to protect the insurance collectively against fraud.

IASIU European Chapter was founded 2001 and the year after we held our first European seminar in Helsingør, Denmark. We will now return to Scandinavia and celebrate IASIU Europe's 10th Seminar & Expo on Insurance Fraud in June 2022 in Malmö, Sweden.
